Subject: Visibility Impact Modeling Request

Dear Mr. Cummins:

This is a request for WRAP to conduct visibility modeling using the California Puff model (CALPUFF) for Utah's Best Available Retrofit Technology (BART) sources, as WRAP is doing for several other WRAP states.

Sources to be modeled. The sources to be modeled are those that Utah has determined to be subject-to-BART. They are two power plants owned by PacifiCorp, Huntington Unit 1 and Hunter Units 1 and 2, in Emery County.

Emission rates. DAQ staff is currently conducting an engineering review to determine emission rates for these facilities.


Receptor sites. All Utah Class I areas -- Arches, Bryce, Canyonlands, Capitol Reef, and Zion National Parks -- are to be included in the modeling. Also, please include Black Canyon of the Gunnison and Flat Tops Wilderness in Colorado.

My staff looks forward to working with WRAP's contractor, Environ, to develop a modeling protocol and complete the analysis.
